# **DISTRICT 25 VOTERS ABANDONING DEMOCRAT PARTY**

**Broward Democrats continue losing voters while Republicans and Independents Surge**

1 Jul 2024

Newly released Broward County and District 25 voter registration data shows Republicans and Independents continue to gain on a rapidly decreasing Democrat voter base.

Continuing the Democrats' downward trajectory in Broward County and District 25 over the past several years, **in the first 6 months of 2024:**

- **FL-25 Democrats **LOST** over 1,500 voters**
- **FL-25 Republicans and Independents **GAINED** nearly 7,000 voters<sup>1</sup>**
- **County-wide, Democrats **LOST** nearly 2,000 voters**
- **County-wide, Republicans and Independents **GAINED** over 17,000 voters**

**Broward County**

Dem: 45.58% (lowest in decades)  
Rep: 22.93%  
Other: 31.50%

**District 25**

Dem: 40.17%  
Rep: 25.67%  
Other: 34.16%

**Just since October 2023, Democrats in FL-25 saw their gap over Republicans shrink from **17.22% to 14.5%**.**

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Eddy stated, *“We have seen many Democrats switch their registration these past several months but that seems to have accelerated after the Presidential debate.”*

Since the 2020 elections, Broward County Democrats saw a 4%+ drop as a percentage of total voters (49.82% to 45.58%) while Republicans saw their share increase 1.63% to 22.93% and Independents grew 2.63%.

FL-25 Republicans saw a similar swing, but just since 2022. Eddy remarked, *“We keep hearing from our residents that they want change and don’t want career politicians in power. The November election will be close with about 7,000 voters making up the winning margin, or 2% of the expected voter turnout. If Republicans and Independents keep gaining voters, this will be enough to tip the election in our favor.”*
