Republicans Gaining in Florida District 25



Newly released Broward County and District 25 voter registration data shows the Eddy For Congress campaign continues to gain supporters.

From January to February 2024, District Democrats lost an additional 100 voters while Republicans gained over 1,200, continuing the Democrats' downward trajectory over the past two years. Independents also increased their total by over 1,200. This continues the trend with Democrats dropping nearly 2% in the past year with those voters going to Republicans and Independents. Demographic and ideological shifts account for most of this change as District 25 residents grow increasingly concerned about the economy and national security.

Chris Eddy, a retired Air Force Reserve Brigadier General, a retired FBI Intelligence leader, an Adjunct Professor at FIU, and a City Commissioner in Weston is looking to unseat long-time Representative Debbie Wasserman Schultz.

With Republicans and Independents now representing nearly 60% of the electorate, General Eddy's common sense approach to fiscal discipline and security is resonating among voters.
