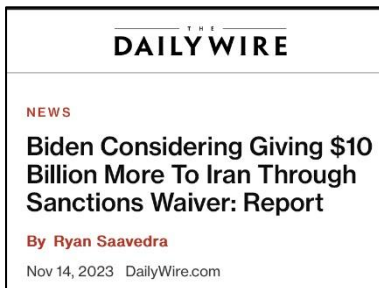
The U.S. Needs to Remain Israel's Strongest Ally
