# Republicans Continue Florida District 25 Growth



## Broward Democrats continue losing voters while Republicans and Independents Surge

2 April 2024

Newly released Broward County and District 25 voter registration data shows the Eddy For Congress campaign continues to gain supporters.

Continuing the Democrats' downward trajectory in Broward County and District 25 over the past several years, in the first three months of 2024:

- Democrats in FL-25 LOST <u>149</u> voters
- Republicans and Independents GAINED nearly <u>5,200</u> registrations<sup>1</sup>
- This continues the multi-year trend with Republicans gaining a 2% swing advantage just over the past 5 months.
- Demographic and ideological shifts account for most of this change as District 25 residents grow increasingly concerned about the economy and national security.

#### District 25 since 1 January 2024

With Republicans and Independents now representing nearly 60% of the electorate, General Eddy's common sense approach to fiscal discipline and security is resonating among voters.

Eddy stated, "The District and the County are following national trends and as our communities become more diverse, they are looking for the party that best focuses on family, security, and fiscal discipline." While the Broward County Democrats represent 46% of the electorate, District 25 Democrats make up only 40.5% of the total. It has been decades since the Broward Democrat voter registration has been this small of a percentage of the county voter population (45.9%) and No Party Affiliation and other independents have been the largest beneficiary of that dropoff.

Since the 2022 elections, Broward County Republicans have seen a 2% advantage and, coupled with the 1% dropoff in Democrat voters, that 3% swing is significant when electoral margins are thin.

District 25 Republicans have seen a similar 3% swing, but in just the past year. Eddy remarked, "We keep hearing voters talk about being frustrated with the chaos in DC and a strong desire to return to some sort of normalcy, and our campaign aligns perfectly with their interests."
