## Broward Democrats continue losing voters while Republicans and Independents Surge

**Voter Registration in Decades** 

2 May 2024

Newly released Broward County and District 25 voter registration data shows the Eddy For Congress campaign against Congresswoman Debbie Wasserman Schultz continues to gain supporters.

Continuing the Democrats' downward trajectory in Broward County and District 25 over the past several years, in the first four months of 2024:

- Democrats in FL-25 LOST <u>32</u> voters
- Republicans and Independents GAINED nearly 7,000 registrations<sup>1</sup>
- This continues the multi-year trend with Republicans gaining a 2% swing advantage just over the past 5 months.
- Demographic and ideological shifts account for most of this change as District 25 residents grow increasingly concerned about the economy and national security.

Democrats now represent just 40.37% of District 25. With Republicans and Independents now representing nearly 60% of the electorate, General Eddy's common sense approach to fiscal discipline and security is resonating among voters.

Eddy stated, *"We meet Democrats every day who say it is not the Party of Kennedy any longer....it's not even the party of Clinton."* While the Broward County Democrats represent less than 46% of the electorate, District 25 Democrats make up only 40% of the total. It has been decades since the Broward Democrat voter registration has been this small of a percentage of the county voter population (45.78%) and No Party Affiliation and other independents have been the largest beneficiary of that dropoff.

Since the 2020 elections, Broward County Democrats saw a 4% drop as a percentage of total voters (49.82% to 45.78%) while Republicans saw their share increase 1.59% to 22.89% and Independents grew 2.53%.

District 25 Republicans saw a similar swing, but in just the past year. Eddy remarked, "The November election will be close with a spread of about 7,000 voters, or 2% of the expected voter turnout. If Republicans and Independents keep gaining 1,500 voters a month, this will be enough to tip the election in our favor."
