DISTRICT 25 REPUBLICAN REGISTRATIONS CONTINUE SURGE

FL-25 Democrat registrations dip AGAIN and remain below critical 40% threshold

3 September 2024

Broward County and District 25 voter registration data shows Republicans and Independents continue to gain on a rapidly decreasing Democrat voter base.

Continuing the Democrats' downward trajectory in Broward County and District 25 over the past several years, **since January 2024**:

- **FL-25 Democrats gained 25 voters**
- **FL-25 Republicans and Independents gained over 12,000 voters¹**
- **County-wide, Democrats gained under 3,000 voters**
- **County-wide, Republicans and Independents gained over 29,000 voters**

Broward County

Dem: 45.33% (lowest in decades)
 Rep: 23.10% (highest since 2012)
 Other: 31.57%

District 25

Dem: 39.91% (down from 41% in Jan 2024)
 Rep: 25.87%
 Other: 34.22%

Just since October 2023, Democrats in FL-25 saw their gap over Republicans shrink from 17.22% to 14.04%.
