Tim Canova, the South Florida law professor who challenged Debbie Wasserman Schultz, the incumbent Congresswoman and then the chair of the Democratic National Committee, in a hotly contested Democrat primary in 2016, has endorsed Chris Eddy, the Republican retired Brigadier General who is running now against Wasserman Schultz in Tuesday's general election.

Canova said today he met several times with Eddy and is impressed with his honesty, integrity, and his agenda to improve the lives of all people in South Florida. According to Canova, *"Chris Eddy understands the most important issues facing South Florida and the nation at large. He recognizes the open border has endangered our national security while undermining job markets for low-income wage earners, particularly in black and Hispanic communities, and raising the costs of rental housing and crime rates."*

Canova also spoke about how inflation has made life more difficult for so many people. He said, *"Chris Eddy knows how the Biden/Harris energy policies have raised fuel and food prices across the board. Higher inflation, in turn, has led to higher interest rates which have made home-ownership unaffordable for so many."*

Canova stressed Eddy's foreign policy and national security experience. *"Chris Eddy is also a steadfast supporter of Israel,"* he said, *"in contrast to Wasserman Schultz who gives lip service to Israel while supporting foreign policies that have sent billions of dollars directly to the Islamic Republic of Iran and indirectly to Hamas and Hezbollah. That's because Wasserman Schultz always puts partisan politics ahead of the interests of the American people."*

Canova, who changed his party affiliation from Democrat to independent in 2018, continues to speak about the need for reforms to restore integrity to our elections and make them far more transparent and verifiable. His own 2016 election against Wasserman Schultz was marred by allegations of election rigging when Brenda Snipes, then the Broward Supervisor of Elections and a political crony of Wasserman Schultz, admitted to illegally destroying every ballot cast in their primary.

Chris Eddy is running for U.S. Congress in Florida's 25th District to Stop the Chaos. He is a retired Air Force Reserve Brigadier General, a retired FBI Intelligence Leader, a Weston City Commissioner, an
