Our elected officials should be broadening ballot access

and should focus on OUR District and NOT the WASHINGTON District

Congresswoman Debbie Wasserman Schultz wants to deny former President Donald Trump access to the ballot for the November 2024 election.¹ She and Representative Jamie Rask in (D-MD) introduced legislation in 2022² to prevent candidates from holding office if they committed insurrection. They are reintroducing that legislation to prevent a candidate from seeking office.

Chris Eddy, a candidate opposing Congresswoman Wasserman Schultz in the November 2024, said, "Instead of seeking to squash democracy and the will of the people, our elected officials should be focused on the needs of their constituents. Regardless of how one feels about President Trump, the voters should decide, especially since many



voters—from both sides of the aisle—now see evidence of a two-tiered system of justice."

Florida District 25 residents consistently state the economy and inflation are their top concerns followed by border security and a lack of faith in the federal government. "I plan on bringing civility back into government and will focus solely on the needs of our residents without feeling pressured from the DC politicians to back their pet projects," Eddy stated. "Civility, Fiscal Discipline, and Security are the hallmarks of our campaign and we continue to gain support from Democrats, Republicans, and Independents who feel their elected representatives are not focused on what's important."

Chris Eddy is running for U.S. Congress in Florida's 25th District to Stop the Chaos. He is a retired Air Force Reserve Brigadier General, a retired FBI Intelligence Leader, a Weston City Commissioner, an award-winning teacher, community leader, and a devoted husband and father.
