While Chris Eddy's effort against long-time Congresswoman Debbie Wasserman Schultz in Florida's 25th Congressional District came up short, he earned the highest percentage of votes for a Republican candidate in District history.

Weston City Commissioner, retired Air Force Brigadier General Chris Eddy, lost to 20-year Democrat incumbent, Debbie Wasserman Schultz, in Florida's 25th Congressional District.
