Republicans Continue Surge in Florida District 25

Broward Democrats are at lowest point in decades

10 March 2024

Newly released Broward County and District 25 voter registration data shows the Eddy For Congress campaign continues to gain supporters.

Since January 2024, **Democrats in FL-25 lost 27 voters while Republicans and Independents gained nearly 4,000 registrations**, continuing the Democrats’ downward trajectory over the past two years.¹

- **This continues the multi-year trend with Republicans gaining a 2% swing advantage just over the past 5 months.**
- Demographic and ideological shifts account for most of this change as District 25 residents grow increasingly concerned about the economy and national security.

With Republicans and Independents now representing nearly 60% of the electorate, General Eddy’s common sense approach to fiscal discipline and security is resonating among voters.

Eddy stated, “Our team is out every day registering and re-registering voters and, regardless of party, we want people to participate in our great electoral process.” It has been decades since the Broward Democrat Party has been this small of a percentage of the county voter population (46%) and No Party Affiliation and other independents have been the largest beneficiary of that dropoff.

District 25 Democrats have seen a more rapid dropoff than the county with about a 2% swing in just the past two years. “Many of our residents are tired of DC politics and are looking for more normal people who will represent their interests and not Washington’s interests.”
