Supreme Court Student Loan Decision

Congressional Candidate Chris Eddy Addresses Supreme Court Decision on Student Loans.

Today, Chris Eddy, GOP candidate for Congress in District 25, South Florida, a retired Air Force Reserve Brigadier General, a retired FBI Intelligence leader, and a City Commissioner in Weston, FL expressed his support for the Supreme Court's decision on student loans, underscoring his commitment to responsible and efficient use of federal dollars.

"The Supreme Court's ruling today is a testament to the principles of fiscal responsibility and accountability," said Eddy. "As a candidate who values prudent use of taxpayer dollars, I believe this decision is a step in the right direction."

Eddy's stance contrasts with President Biden's controversial plan to forgive student loans, which he argues may inadvertently encourage irresponsible borrowing and place an unnecessary burden on taxpayers.

"Forgiving loans without addressing the root causes of the student debt crisis could potentially lead to a cycle of debt forgiveness, undermining the principle of personal responsibility," Eddy explained. "While we must empathize with those struggling under the weight of student loans, we also must ensure we have a robust economy where students have the ability to pay back the loans themselves."

Eddy remains committed to meeting the needs of his constituents in District 25. "I understand the financial strain many families are under," he said. "Americans' disposable spending has decreased in the past three years and we need to reverse that trend by getting our federal spending in line with historical norms. **We can't continue to pay nearly \$500 million a year in interest on the debt...that's more than we spend on our veterans!**"
